**PRICE REALISATION ON EXPORT OF REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS**

2376 SHRI DEREK O' BRIEN:

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the per unit price realisation for the export of refined petroleum products from India has significantly decreased during the last year;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether it would be possible for Government to cut down the losses on price realisation; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (d): The prices of petroleum products in the international market are decided commercially and are mutually agreed upon between parties concerned. These may vary across companies, consignments and time periods.
