- (b) whether Government is providing or considering to provide financial and technical support to the States particularly affected by Sickie Cell Anaemia; and
- (c) the details of funds (in ₹) allocated to Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) under CSIR Sickie Cell Anaemia Mission since inception of the scheme, year-wise?

- (a) The Statewise details of diseased patients registered on Sickie Cell portal, as on 22.07.2025, is at Annexure.
- (b) This Ministry provides technical and financial support to the States/UTs for conducting screenings, procurement of drugs, counselling & awareness camps, training of human resource, blood transfusion services for sickie cell anaemia, based on the proposals received in the form of Programme Implementation Plans (PIPs) under National Health Mission (NHM).
- (c) Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) Sickie Cell Anaemia (SCA) Mission is fully funded through the internal resources of CSIR. No funds were provided/allocated by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare for the same. The budget allocated by CSIR in its SCA Mission (2017-2025) is as under:
